GREEN POOL WATER & FLOCCING

- 1. Manually vacuum the pool to waste, slowly.
- 2. Refill pool, test the water, and balance your pH & Alkalinity, 7.2 7.6 & 60 120, respectively.
- 3. At night, add 1 bag of shock per 5,000 gallons of pool water and filter on high overnight.
- 4. The next morning, backwash the pool until the sight glass is clear and then rinse for 2–3 minutes.
- 5. Set your multiport valve to recirculate.
- 6. Add 8 16 oz of Super Fall Out per 20,000 gallons of pool water, depending on the level of cloudiness.
- 7. Continuously circulate the pool water for 4 hours and then shut down the pool pump completely. Allow the pool to sit with no activity for 24 hours all debris should fall to the bottom of the pool in this time frame.
- 8. Vacuum manually to WASTE to remove all debris from the pool make sure to vacuum very slowly.
- 9. Refill pool, and turn the multiport valve back to 'filter' retest and balance your pH & alkalinity.
- 10. Additional settling of debris may occur for up to 3 days, requiring additional vacuuming.
