PURE N BLUE POOL START UP

These are instructions on how to start up your pool with our Pure N Blue line of copper based sanitizers. You will follow these instructions only when adding chemicals to a fresh filled pool for the first time – either immediately after installation, liner replacement, or if converting your pool from salt or chlorine to copper. Your pH and Alkalinity must be balanced before starting this process – pH 7.2 –7.6 and alkalinity 60 – 120.

DAY ONE:

- In the morning, add 2 oz. of Pure N Blue FRESH for every 1,000 gallons of water (refer to pool sizing chart on the back) and filter on high for the day.
- That night, add 1 bag of chlorine shock for every 10,000 gallons of water. Run pool on 'filter' overnight with your pump on high.

DAY TWO:

- The next morning, backwash your filter until the water is clear and then rinse the filter, again, until the water is clear.
- · Add Pure N Blue CLEAR 3 oz for every 2,000 gallons of water.
- For the next 2 weeks, make sure to maintain your pH in the range of 7.2 7.6. Do not add any more Pure N Blue to the pool. After 2 weeks, you will begin the Pure N Blue Maintenance Schedule.
